

Flooring Specifications



All of our flooring is milled from selectively harvested local timber that is cut by a Certified Public Logger that practices sustainable forestry.

The process is controlled right from the point of log selection to suit your order and project requirement.

We dry all of our flooring to 8% moisture content.

All flooring is solid wood and milled to a 3/4 inch thickness with a tongue and groove profile and stress relief back.

If you received a sample, just remember that it is a small representative slice of the many possible combinations of color, grains and knots that can be found in one type of flooring.

Ordering Information

All of our flooring is custom made for each order to maintain uniformity, color and size. We price our flooring and lumber products online in order to give you the full freedom to receive a complete quote without the undue hassles of feeling obligated.

Payment

A job order containing a full description of your order, to include estimated shipping dates and prepaid shipping costs will be mailed, faxed or emailed to you, your choice. We request that you please sign the agreement and return it to Maine Timber Works with a deposit of 50% of your total order. Upon receipt of your deposit and signed agreement, we will begin processing your order. We require that the remaining balance be paid in full before shipment.

Shipping

Here at Maine Timber Works, we use both our own trucks and common carrier (i.e. Conway Trucking) for shipping. Shipping is figured by the distance traveled, and the weight and size of your order. In the Northeast, we generally use our own trucks. This gives us much more flexibility scheduling your deliveries.

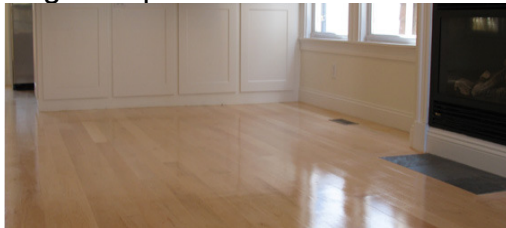

Mostly clear and wide, Eastern White Pine flooring has few scattered small tight knots. Random widths 12" - 20" and random lengths ranging from 5 to 12 feet. Real nice!

This selection is one of our most popular and traditional of all our plank flooring. With the wide range of widths offered in this grade it not only keeps with tradition but helps to accentuate the extreme widths that accompanies this classic floor. Widths range from 5" - 19", with lengths ranging from 5 to 12 feet with an occasional 14 to 16 foot plank added. Good, sound, tight numerous red knots make up the face of this New England Classic.

Important Notice

It is important to note that all real wood flooring must be allowed to stabilize inside of your house for 7 to 10 days minimum prior to any installation. This helps reduce any chance of extreme expansion or contractions of the joints once your flooring has been installed. Remember, wood is an equalizer and will lose or take on surrounding ambient moisture conditions. This is why your home moves with the different seasons of the year.
